A Message from the Pastor

What Are You Reading?

Your word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path. Psalm 119:105

What are you reading?

A friend of mine asked me this question the other day.

It's a good measure to determine if you are still learning and growing. In fact, I find that the times I am "too busy" to read, my ideas begin to plateau.

There is a decline in reading in our society for a host of reasons: busyness, technology, entertainment, education,...

Ironically, our society is reading more, but it tends to be social media feeds. I'm not against this per se, but I do think it's important for our minds to wrestle with something deeper. Reading helps feed the mind with ideas and intellectual curiosity.

Currently, I am reading 2 books:

[The Pastor in the Secular Age](#) by Andrew Root and [How to Know Someone](#) by David Brooks.

The premise of [The Pastor in the Secular Age](#) is essentially as the world has become more and more disenchanted with wonder, the divine experience has been compartmentalized to a smaller and smaller portion of people's lives. Therefore, the role of the pastor has shifted.

This book has been helpful in exploring my own pastoral identity and resonates with many of the experiences I encounter. My hope is that it reorients and reaffirms my own calling in this particularly unique time in history as a minister of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

[How to Know Someone](#) is just an easy read when it comes to being better listeners. In our fast-paced world, we have not developed the critical skills of listening and being present in one another's lives. I highly recommend this book for anyone not only to develop your skills as a listener, but to spark curiosity through the recognition that everyone has their own incredible story, experience, and journey to be explored. Ultimately deep down inside we desire to be known.

On top of that, I've been striving to read the Bible in a year. This year, I'm listening to Father Mike Schmidt on the Bible in a Year Podcast. It takes me about 15-20 minutes a day. I've read on my own the scriptures, but it's different to hear the word read in another voice.

And truth be told, reading is sometimes onerous, so I can listen to someone's voice reading while I am brushing my teeth or making my coffee. Therefore, it doesn't really take anything away from my day if I'm feeling stretched thin.

However, it does add to my day because it frames every other moment. It helps me to experience each conversation, task, moment with a faith lens.

The words of Scripture speak deeply and help frame every moment that is to come so that I remember I'm connected to a larger story even in the midst of the countless stories I encounter.

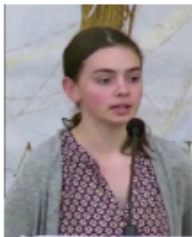
